Ground Volunteer Pins & Certificates of Appreciation: Issued from [EAA Young Eagles Office](#). Flight line pins and Certificates of Appreciation can be awarded on an annual basis to any volunteer who devotes their time to assist at Young Eagles events during the year. The Pin is dated with the year, allowing annual awards to consistent volunteers.
